Language Arts Goals:

1. To develop an expanded vocabulary.
2. To encourage correct pronunciation.
3. To indentify upper case letters.
4. To become familiar with beginning letter sounds.
5. To begin to use a pencil and crayons.
6. To learn songs, poems and finger plays.

Math Goals:

1. To count numbers one to ten.
2. To identify numbers one to ten.
3. To assign an object to a number.
4. To learn basic shapes.
5. To learn to work left to right and top to bottom.
6. To identify eight primary colors.
7. To understand large and small.
8. To understand shorter and longer.

Science Goals:

1. To identify various types of weather.
2. To learn how to dress appropriately for a particular type of weather.
3. To study plant life and how a plant grows from a seed to a plant.
4. To learn the elements necessary for plant growth.

Social Studies:

1. To understand we are an important part of a family and a class unit.
2. To understand that rules teach responsibility.
3. To learn how to share and play with peers.
4. To learn and celebrate various holidays.
